## HOW IT WORKS

Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University Women's Giving Circle members pool their charitable funds to create powerful change in aerospace and aviation education. By giving collectively in this way, members have **the opportunity to help** direct scholarship support and determine critical industry education needs — an enriching experience for all involved.

As our membership grows, so too does our ability to expand our reach and **our impact** on the aviation and aerospace community.

## GIVE

Every year, each member's **annual contribution** of at least **\$1,200** goes to the scholarship pool, with \$200 set aside for the endowment fund.

## VOTE

With **“one member, one vote,”** Women's Giving Circle members ratify scholarship awardees from worthy student applications.

## GRANT

**Scholarships** are awarded to Embry-Riddle students each year, presented at the annual **Women in Aviation Conference**, where they have the unique opportunity to network with industry female professionals.

## MEMBERSHIP LEVELS

### **ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP** /// **\$1,200 per year**

Through the power of collective giving, a single annual gift of \$1,200 ensures a strong future for young women studying to become leaders in the aerospace and aviation industries. \$200 of your gift goes toward the Embry-Riddle Women's Giving Circle endowment, ensuring that female students' financial-aid needs are addressed for years to come.

### **LEGACY MEMBERSHIP** /// **\$25,000 one-time**

Your one-time gift of \$25,000 or more (payable over five years) provides a lifetime Legacy Membership and perpetual support for Embry-Riddle's Women's Giving Circle scholarship fund.

### **LAUNCH MEMBERSHIP** /// **Women 40 and under**

Women 40 and under have an opportunity to join the Embry-Riddle Women's Giving Circle at an annual contribution of \$250. Participants have full voting rights and are encouraged to reach out to Embry-Riddle's female students to provide insight and guidance as they launch their own careers.

### **CORPORATE ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP**

Designed for corporations providing services to the aviation and aerospace industries, this non-voting membership level starts at \$5,000 annually and provides support to the scholarship endowment fund.

### **SUPPLEMENTAL GIFTS**

From time to time, members may choose to make an optional supplemental gift. These donations may be made either to our annual term scholarship pool or to help grow our endowment fund.



**Women's philanthropy through the power of collective giving is a potent force.**


